

Some things you should know before deciding if you are interested in a South Peach Frenchie:

- Prior to being considered for one of our puppies, prospective owners must complete and return the following application and provide two personal references, a letter of reference from their vet, and if possible, have a home visit.
- ✤ If we have a suitable puppy available, a reservation deposit fee of \$1000 will be required to hold the puppy for you with a signed deposit contract. Reservation deposit fees are accepted on approval only. Final decision to sell any puppy will not be made until after we have met you in person.
- Reservation fee is non-refundable. However, a full refund will be made if at any point we determine that the puppy we have selected for you is not suitable and another puppy will not be available from this litter or a future litter.
- Companion puppies are sold on limited registration with a contract requirement for spaying or neutering after 12 months of age and prior to 24 months of age.
- Companion puppies do not receive registration until proof of spay/neuter per contract.
- Show prospects are sold on full registration with co-ownership agreement contract.
- Puppies are given registered names selected by us and registered by us. Owners are free to use a "call" name of their choice.
- Puppy owners are requested to contact us at minimum every six months for the lifetime of the dog. They are also requested to contact us in the event of illness, injury, or behavior problems.
- Puppies typically are not selected until after they have been evaluated at 8 weeks old. Puppies are not placed until they are at least 10 weeks old and have been vetted and microchipped.
- Puppy immunizations are started by our vet at 7 weeks of age and must be continued according to protocol. If this protocol is not followed, contractual health guarantees <u>will</u> <u>not</u> be valid.
- We do not ship our puppies. We may possibly agree to meet with you at our local airport or personally fly to your local airport at your expense.

Thank you for sharing this information with us - it will help us to select the puppy that best matches your needs and expectations. Our goal is to find homes for our puppies where each will be loved, enjoyed, and appreciated for their own special qualities.
